The climate of the state is warm and sub-humid, so you can choose the season that you like the most to feel the love.





In this Artisan Bakery Workshop they will share the dough, the table and the smile. With the guidance of the house bakers, they will be able to make bread with the traditional recipe of the town, they will bake bread and souvenirs with wood.

Xico's wood-fired bread is a gastronomic product recognized in this region of Veracruz, for its unique flavor. A delicious experience to do as a couple.





## BREAD IS A CELEBRATION

Includes: Workshop, tools, explanation by the baker and the prepared bread. Maximum 6 pieces. The bread will be delivered 2 hours after the workshop, since it is baked at the moment.

#### Duration: 2 hours.

Recommendations: Comfortable clothes. Restrictions: This bread has gluten, chocolate, sugar, nuts. Activity not suitable for people in a wheelchair.

Privacy, good taste, elegance, attention and traditional gastronomy, in a cellar specially prepared for you to top this magical experience in Xico.

#### Includes:

4-course menu of typical food of the region with a gourmet touch, coffee or tea and a bottle of red wine, private cellar area of the El Veintidós restaurant, decoration with candles, centerpiece and details of natural flowers.

Duration: 2 hours.

Recommendations: Dinner time must be confirmed at least 24 hours in advance.


Restrictions: Additional drinks have an extra cost.



## LOVE IS TRADITION

In the town's patronal celebration, Santa María Magdalena is honored, with a parade through the streets with dancers, pyrotechnic bulls, artisanal liquor and a lot of color. One of the iconic elements of this festival, without a doubt, is a colorful painted sawdust mat that begins at the entrance of the town to allow, at night, the majestic entrance of Santa María Magdalena to its main church accompanied by waterfalls of lights and pyrotechnics.







## LOVE IS TRADITION

The design and preparation of this handmade rug takes months for the people of Xico, from the manufacture of stencils, the painting of the sawdust and of course acquiring the correct technique of placing the colors so that the image is perfect. It is an example of devotion, commitment, faith, perseverance and team work. For this reason, we consider this activity to be a one of a kind experience to live the magic and colors of the local festivities.



## LOVE IS TRADITION

Make your mat, trace, intertwine the colors of the paths that you will join. Let the traditions and magic of Xico guide you to a life walking together, step by step, regardless of adversity and enjoying all the delights always hand in hand with your partner.



Includes: Materials and tools for the workshop. Personalized class with the Master Craftsman who will teach you the technique of making the mat. Duration: 2 hours.

Recommendations: Comfortable clothes.







### LOVE IS INTOXICATING

### AFTERNOON OPTION 1

Love is passion, happiness, smile and sparkle in the eyes, complicity in the reflection of the encounter, let's toast with "morita and verde"





Morita is a fruit that grows in the upper part of the town, it is collected and harvest in the month of July, when the ladies with their buckets full of the fruit can be seen offering it house to house.

The liquor artisans are ready to squeeze and ferment the fruit, store and age in the traditional way so that they can taste this elixir of joy that runs through the veins of the party in the month of July, when xiqueños toast and enjoy the time.









### LOVE IS INTOXICATING

### AFTERNOON OPTION 1

Verde is an enigmatic, sweet and intoxicating liquor, made with various wild herbs. They attribute healing and aphrodisiac properties to it.

Mora & Verde, drinks of the town that celebrates, dances and happiness. Let's toast to those who give themselves and embrace their love sown among waterfalls, mountains and coffee plantations.

Includes: Tasting of verde and morita liqueurs. Host by the artisan who handcrafts these nectars.

#### Duration: 2 hours.

Recommendations: Comfortable clothes. Restrictions: Mention if there are allergies to any product, since these liqueurs are made from herbs. Not suitable for minors.



### SENSORIAL LOVE AFTERNOON OPTION 2



From the Matlacobatl ravine to small corners in the center of town, Xico is a coffeegrowing town that processes specialty coffee for local and national use and for export. There are several places for the drying process of the coffee acquire from small owners who take personal care of their farms throughout the year and eagerly await the "mowing" time, which is what they call the harvest season. Some owners have their own workshops and process the coffee taking care of all the details, increasing the value of the product and ensuring that an aromatic coffee, which will make those who taste it sigh.

The flowering of coffee occurs several times a year and you can see the coffee trees covered with a pinwheel-shaped flower in small bouquets on each of the branches, which in addition to having a soft aroma, is a sight to be admired.



### DAY 2

### SENSORIAL LOVE AFTERNOON OPTION 2

A few days later the flowers fall, the green fruit begins to grow and changes color to a reddish tone, which is just when it should be cut.

The cutters start the harvest with a "tenate" at the waist and go with their skillful hands selecting the best fruits.

You will be able to taste different roasts of the bean, for delicate and energetic tastes, select the bean and learn how it is that the washing and drying processes provide different flavors to the palate, all this from the hand of an expert coffee grower of the region.

Love for this land is magic wrapped in the cup of coffee, its aroma and consistency, its passion and its story that begins when at the first sip, they look at each other and share their entire lives.

Includes: Sample of different types of coffee extraction processes, guided by a barista.

#### Duration: 1 hour.

Recommendations: Comfortable clothing, avoid chewing any type of gum, mints and tobacco prior to tasting.

Restrictions: Consider it to be caffeinated coffee. Not suitable for minors.





## ROMANTIC HORSEBACK RIDING THROUGH THE VILLAGE

### ADITIONAL

Nothing like hearing the sound of a horse's footsteps on the historic stone roads.

In this ride you will be able to visit and learn about downtown Xico, Del Llanito small square, De los Portales square, Del Caracol neighborhood, and get away little by little from the bustle of the town to climb the high mountain and contemplate the beautiful landscapes that frame this magical town.

During the tour you will share as a couple the experience of visiting this incredible destination and its surroundings in an unforgettable way.

## ROMANTIC HORSEBACK RIDING THROUGH THE VILLAGE

### ADITIONAL

Includes: Horseback riding through the town with a guide.

Cost: This activity is not included in the experience, it has an additional cost. Duration: 2 hours.

Recommendations: Jeans, boots, booties, closed shoe or sports shoe.

Restrictions: Avoid crocs, sandals, clogs or any other type of footwear that slips or falls easily. This activity is not suitable for those with a spinal injury, inebriated or pregnant.






- Reception at the airport with a welcome sign.

Restrictions: Minimum 20 people, the price may vary depending on the number of people. San Juan de Ulua activities are not available on Mondays.



#### Duration: 10 hours.

Recommendations: Wear comfortable clothes and shoes, indicate if there are guests with special diet. The visit to the waterfalls is not recommended for people with restrict mobility or in a wheelchair.

Restrictions: Minimum 20 people, the price changes depending on the number of participants, it does not include breakfast, during the meal it does not include alcoholic beverages unless mentioned.





### COFFEE LOVE Option 1



You will have a delicious traditional breakfast and later you will visit one of the most emblematic farms in the region, where you will learn the process of extraction and production of coffee.

You will return to the town to be able to make a great traditional bread in one of the bakeries of yesteryear, with their generational tools and their wood oven, you will have a unique experience.

You will return to the hotel so that you can get ready to live one of the best nights in town, the Romanza Xiqueña, a famous tour through the main street of the town. Our meeting point will be on the steps of the Church of Santa María Magdalena.

- Reception at the hotel.
- Transfers to coffee farm.
- Demonstration of coffee extraction methods.
- Tour and visit to la Monja waterfall.
- Tour and visit to Texolo waterfall, optional: a picnic.
- Dinner and visit to "El Paraíso de la Trucha".

#### AFTERNOON

- Tour to Xico Viejo and the Xicochimalco Museum - pre-Hispanic pieces.
- Danzante Museum and / or El Vestido Museum Tour.
- Guided tour of the main street of Xico.
- Time to eat in Xico (El Mesón Xiqueño, option: Campanario)
- Liquor tasting at dinner.
- Back to the hotel.









### COFFEE LOVE Option 1

Includes: Transfers in Sprinter unit for 20 people, tourist guide, tour experience in coffee plantations, guided visit to the Coffee Museum, coffee extraction and tasting workshop, 250 grams of coffee, gastronomic experience in the farm, bakery workshop, basket of bread made in the workshop, entrance to mentioned places, tour in an ornate calandria, 1 hour of mariachis, morita and/or verde drink and 60 cm sparklers (they can be replaced by colored ribbons or flowers), the meal plan includes food and non-alcoholic beverages.

#### Duration: 12 hours.

Recommendations: Wear comfortable clothes and shoes, indicate if there are guests with special diet, indicate if there are allergies to flour, yeast or any ingredient in the bakery or pastry, an activity suitable for everybody.

Restrictions: Minimum 20 people, the price changes depending on the number of participants, it does not include breakfast, during the meal it does not include alcoholic beverages unless mentioned.

If you like adventure, this will be one of the best days, you will experience adrenaline in this incredible river descent, for two and a half hours in one of the best rafting areas in the country.

At the end enjoy a moment of relaxation during the meal on the riverbank.

In the afternoon, we return to the hotel so that you can get ready to experience one of the best nights in town.

The Romanza Xiqueña, the great and famous tour through the main street of the town. Our meeting point will be on the steps of the Church of Santa María Magdalena.

Music, verde, morita and sparklers are part of the party. We will accompany the couple in an incredible calandria pulled by horses, until we reach the icebreaker.

#### MORNING

- Reception at the hotel to go to Jalcomulco.
- Welcome at the camp and safety talk for the rafting activity in Jalcomulco (Chichaki for lunch).
- Transfer to the river bank to start the descent at 2:30 h, in the middle of the route there is a break to hydrate and regain energy, then we continue with the tour.
- At the end of the tour, you are taken to Chichaki for lunch on the riverbank.
- Return to Xico.

#### AFTERNOON

Romanza Xiqueña includes mariachi, decorated calandria for a typical prewedding tour of Xico, morita and verde liquor, traditional sparklers (can be substituted by colored ribbons or flowers). It starts at the church and ends at Las Magdalenas Hotel Boutique.

Icebreaker option with additional cost if desired.







# DESCEND IN TO THE HEART OF VERACRUZ

#### OPTION 2

Includes: Transfers in a Sprinter unit for 20 people, explanation of descent, rafting activity two and a half hours, hydrating drinks during the activity, food on the riverbank, the meal plan includes food and non-alcoholic beverages, decorated calandria tour, one hour of mariachis, morita and / or verde liquor and 60 cm sparklers (they can be changed to colored ribbons or flowers).

#### Duration: 12 hours.

Recommendations: Bring clothes and shoes for swimming, a change of clothes for after the descent, do not bring valuables that can fall during the activity, indicate if there are guests with special diet, you do not need to know how to swim, people in wheelchairs that can follow instructions and with arm mobility and strength can do the activity.

Restrictions: Minimum 20 people, the price changes depending on the number of participants, it does not include breakfast. During the meal it does not include alcoholic beverages unless mentioned. Minimum age for rafting is 8 years or 40 kg minimum and a maximum of 150 kg.

Facing the mountains in a natural paradise you can relax and express your true love creating a unique atmosphere on your wedding day.



Includes: One hour meditation session, meditation instructor. Duration: 2 hours.

Recommendations: Wear comfortable clothing that allows free movement. Activity without restrictions, suitable for everyone. It is suggested to do it in the morning. Restrictions: Maximum 10 people per workshop. If the group is larger, the workshop is divided into different times respecting groups of 10 people.





The colored sawdust rugs is a handiwork with a lot of tradition, dedication and with a thousand shapes and figures.

Includes: Instructor, material for making a 2 m by 1.5 m sawdust mat at the ceremony or venue.

#### Duration: 2 hours.

Recommendations: Wear comfortable clothes. Activity without restrictions, suitable for everyone.

Restrictions: Workshop and price for 10 people per group, if the group is larger it is divided into the workshop at different times respecting groups of 10 people. The next group can be programmed at the end of the first one.

The streets of the town are painted in colors in the largest festival of the entire region.



CEREMONY

There a variety of imposing and wonderful constructions dating from the 16th to the 19th centuries! How would you like to have your civil or spiritual ceremony in the hall of the Francisco X. Clavijero Theater located in the Historic downtown of the City of Veracruz, under its surprising giant chandelier, or even between its curtains on the stage?

The Francisco X. Clavijero Theater was inaugurated in 1902. Its façade is neoclassical in style although it reveals certain touches of French influence, its gigantic and fine mirrors and marble floors give it a certain aristocratic air, making it one of the scenic spaces with greatest tradition in the city.





### THE CEREMONY

Do you prefer outdoors? An intimate ceremony in the center of Casa de Hernan Cortes in the city of La Antigua is an excellent option.

In this Sevillian-style construction there is an almost intact waterwheel from which the water was obtained, a large part of the rooms that surround the central patio are still standing and it is impressive to see the walls that mix bricks with coral stones, the rustic clay floors are maintained and there is even a bread oven that is kept in perfect condition.

There are three rooms that protect the roots of the lovers, the most photographed and the greatest attraction of the place. So it will be impressive for your guests to see in the so-called Cortes room, how the roots of the trees grow in to the place. It seems they are telling the history of the conquest, of everything that this house lived through and of the evolution of Mexico. A whole poem that will complement your love story!

## THE CEREMONY

## CEREMONY

And for a Catholic ceremony, the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Assumption, built at the beginning of the 17th century, in a magnificent and sober neoclassical style with its simple lines and its poblano tile dome, is definitely the perfect setting.

Duration: 1 hour and 30 minutes. Minimum: 20 people. Includes: Transfers (Hotel - Cathedral - Hotel). Priest. Ceremony. Decoration.



The moment of celebration has arrived! How about venues such as the Betlemita former convent, the Atarazanas Building, the City Museum, the Old San Carlos Military Hospital or the Julio S. Montero cobbled pedestrian street, framed by some of these buildings.

#### **BETLEMITA FORMER CONVENT**

It is one of the most emblematic buildings in the city of Veracruz, since it represents the Buenos Aires architecture built in the mid-18th century. It has been a convent for the friars of the religious order of the betlemitas, a school and a hospital. Today it is the headquarters building of the Veracruzano Institute of Culture and is dedicated to the development of cultural and artistic activities of the State.



#### ATARAZANAS CULTURAL CENTER


It is an 18th century construction, whose style corresponds to the architectural influences of that time: herrerian architecture, a highly authentic military model. In medieval Spain it served to defend the coasts and rivers through which various goods were traded. In Veracruz it functioned only as a warehouse, since the port was guarded by the fortress of San Juan de Ulua and the Baluarte de Santiago. The building, already restored, was inaugurated on April 21, 1991 under the tutelage of the Veracruzano Institute of Culture. Today it has become a space for tart and culture with a strong inclination towards popular and community trends.





MUSE

It is a two-story magnificent building with an architectural composition of neoclassical style from the mid and late nineteenth century. With its gigantic main wooden door, its beautiful bronze gate with secondary doors and its central patio surrounded by beams galleries and arcades with pilasters and columns, it is the ideal place for your celebration.



#### SAN CARLOS FORMER MILITAR HOSPITAL

It was the first military hospital in Mexico and in all of America; It was built with sea stone within the walls that surrounded the city and it was inaugurated in December 1764 by the name of San Carlos hospital. With a neoclassical military architectural style built with mask stone, it has been considered one of the most important points of concentration and attention for civilians, sea and land troops who were injured during the fighting that took place in the heroic defenses of the port.




#### JULIO S. MONTERO PEDESTRIAN STREET

> It was adapted for exclusive pedestrian use and rehabilitated with paving stone. It is framed by the buildings of the Atarazanas Cultural Center, the Former Betlemita Convent, the Illustrious Veracruzano Institute and the Mexico Naval Museum. If you imagine your reception outdoors, this venue is a dream through time.




### RIO BLANCO FORMER TEXTILE FACTORY



It was inaugurated in 1892, during Porfirio Diaz regime, when the industrial sector in Mexico had an important boom, particularly in textiles. The Rio Blanco Textile Factory was the largest yarn and fabric factory in Latin America, located in the center of Rio Blanco town, and has witnessed great historical figures.

Whether in its gardens or in the house, this emblematic venue is the perfect setting to host the beginning your new story.



### MIERYPESADO POLIFORUM

The architectural design of the Mier y Pesado building, inaugurated in 1944, is unique in the State of Veracruz, due to its size and shape, which resembles that of a castle. Its splendor makes it classified as one of the main works of the 19th century in Orizaba.

Its construction, in an eclectic style, was designed by the architect Juan Segura. The cantera stone with which it was built and the top of its arches gives it a unique look. Other representative elements of this are its gardens, with trees, shrubs, figures and majestic fountain. All this makes it the perfect setting for your wonderful union.



### EL PALACIO DE HIERRO




If you are looking for a one of a kind places, this valuable construction is the maximum icon of Art Nouveau (Neoclassical French Renaissance) in Mexico, and the only iron palace in the world. It was designed by the Frenchman, Alexandre Gustave Eiffel, in 1891, at the request of the then mayor, Julio M. Vélez, with the purpose of having a Municipal Palace that will contrast with the architecture of Orizaba. It cost 80 thousand pesos in gold, and it was built in 1892 in the workshops of the Societé Anonymé des Forges D'Aiseau in Belgium, based on metal sheets, posts, screws, wooden doors and cast iron ornaments. It is located in front of the Cathedral of San Miguel Archangel, in the Historic downtown. This magnificent venue will be the perfect backdrop for your wedding, allowing you to have that unique exclusive touch that you have always wanted for that special day.



### IGNACIO DE LA LLAVE THEATRE

Its construction lasted 20 years, from 1855 to 1875, being the first theater in the country that had a wooden dome. Its architecture is inspired by a Florentine palace. Today the foyer is available for your reception





### SAN JOSE FORMER CONVENT

It is a set of buildings with a neoclassical architecture that reveals the academic taste of San Carlos, built by the Franciscans in the style of the Franciscan Third Order. It is located in the center of the city of Orizaba and perfect for a classic wedding.


